How to Use KINVET OvuLay

Daily Dose for Layers (17–38 weeks)

- Mix 500 g of KINVET OvuLay into 1 ton of feed each day.

Daily Dose for Breeders

- Mix 750 g–1 kg per 1 ton of feed all through their laying period.

When Production Dips

- If egg numbers drop, shells get thin, or hatchlings are weak:
 - For 3–4 weeks, bump up to 750 g (layers) or 1 kg (breeders) per ton.
 - Then go back to your normal dose once things look back to normal.

Farmhand Favorites: Do's

1. Keep It Dry & Cool

- Store KINVET OvuLay in a **sealed/closed bag** out of direct sun and away from damp spots.
- Moisture weakens the herbs—always close the bag.

2. Mix It Well

- Sprinkle the powder **slowly** into your mixer so every grain gets a little bit.
- If all the feed smells the same faint herb scent, you're good to go.

3. Check Your Birds Daily

- Look at egg counts, shell strength, and how chicks hatch.

4. Keep the Coop Fresh

- Scoop out wet bedding and add clean, dry litter.
- Wipe down feeders and drinkers so nothing grows in the corners.

5. Safe for All Ages

Farmer's Don'ts – Avoid These Mistakes:

1. Don't Guess on Amount

- Over-dosing won't speed up results and wastes product. Follow the guide.

- Air and humidity degrade the botanicals. Keep it sealed/closed tight.

3. Don't Let Feed Go Bad

- Store your feed right in a clean place.

4. Don't Skip Equipment Cleaning

- Dirty feeders and drinkers harbor pathogens.. Wash them every day.

5. Don't Forget Biosecurity

- Footbaths, clean boots, and fewer visitors help keep disease— key factors in good reproduction.
