How to Use KINVET HeatRex

Daily usage for Dairy Cattle:

- ◆ **Large Animals (Cows/Bufferaloes):**
 - 100 g per animal per day
 - ◆ **Small Ruminants (Goats/Calves):**
 - 50 g per animal per day
 - ◆ **Administration:**
 - Mix with drinking water or TMR (Total Mixed Ration)
 - Ensure uniform mixing for best results.

FarmHand favorites: Do's

✓ Keep it Dry & Sealed

Moisture affects product efficacy. Store in a cool, dry place—away from sunlight and rain.

✓ Mix It Right

Add to feed or dissolve in clean water. Stir well before offering to animals.

✓ Pair with Clean Water

Ensure animals have unrestricted access to drinking water for optimal hydration.

✓ Track Animal Behavior

Monitor for signs of improvement: reduced panting, better appetite, and stable milk yield.

✓ Use During Evening Hours

If heat peaks mid-day, give during cooler hours for better intake.

Farmer's Don'ts – Avoid These Mistakes:

⊘ Don't Skip During Heatwaves

Waiting too long can lead to irreversible losses in yield and animal comfort.

⊘ Don't Mix with Wet Feed

Avoid damp or fermenting feed to prevent clumping and spoilage.

⊘ Don't Double Dose Suddenly

Excess electrolytes may lead to loose stools. Stick to the recommended amounts.

⊘ Don't Use As Water Replacement

HeatRex is not a substitute for clean water—it's a hydration *support*, not the main source.

⊘ Don't Neglect Shade & Ventilation

Use HeatRex *with* cooling strategies like fans, misting, or shaded resting areas.
