How to Use KINVET LactUp

- ◆ Administer twice daily—morning and evening feeding.
 - ◆ Use continuously for at least 60 days for optimal milk yield and feed efficiency or as advised by your veterinarian.

Farmer Practices: Do's

- ✓ During early and mid-lactation for peak yield
 - ✓ In cows and buffaloes with suboptimal milk production
 - ✓ After calving for post-parturition recovery and energy boost
 - ✓ In herds with poor feed-to-milk conversion ratios
 - ✓ During periods of heat or nutritional stress affecting DMI
 - ✓ As part of daily ration to maintain consistent milk quality
 - ✓ When aiming to reduce feed costs while maintaining high output

Farmer's Don'ts – Avoid These Mistakes:

- ✗ Don't skip daily doses—it reduces effectiveness
 - ✗ Don't mix with hot mash or water—it may reduce potency
 - ✗ Don't rely on KVC-LactUp alone—ensure clean water and balanced rations
 - ✗ Don't store in open or moist places—always seal the pack after use
 - ✗ Don't delay intervention in low-yielding animals—early support ensures faster recovery
